



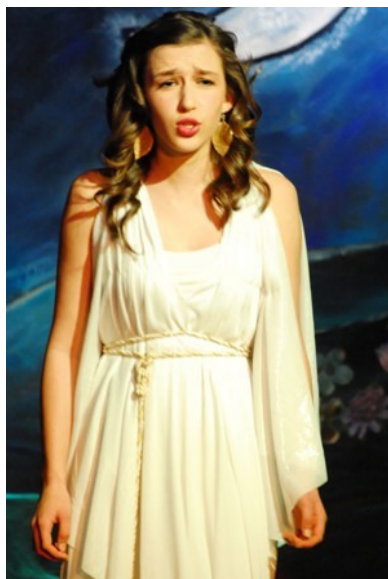

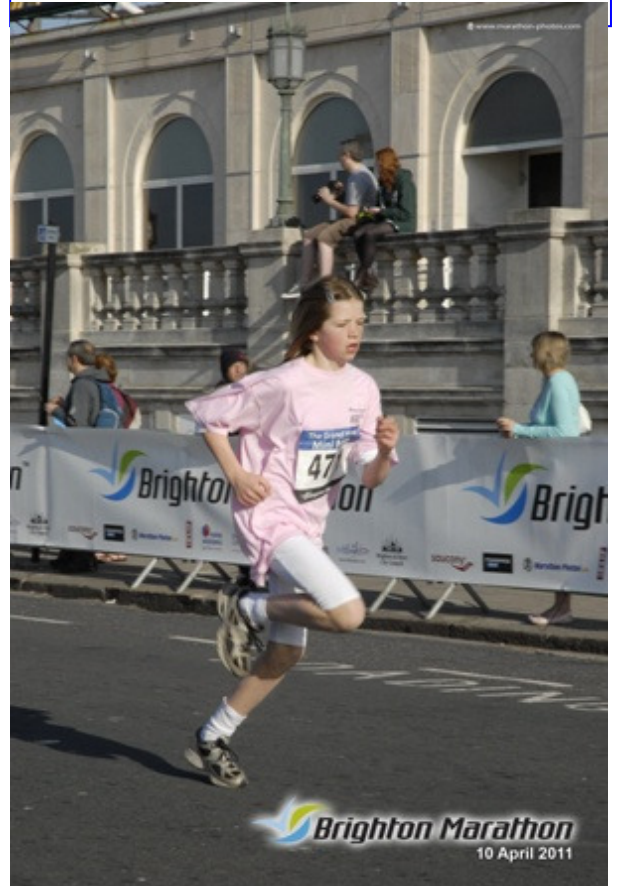
Pre-Prep Arts Express Day - Whatever Next!

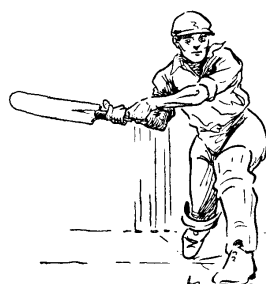
